Spring 2012 Senior Exam Exemption Policy

Each Senior has the opportunity to be exempt from each of their senior exams provided they meet the following 2-part criteria for each class in the second semester of 2012.

Part One: *Intellectually Equipped*

To be exempt from a senior exam, a student must meet one of the following criteria for each class they wish to be exempt from:

1. A grade of 90 (Average for S2) or higher and no more than 4 absences in the class.
2. A grade of 80 (Average for S2) or higher and no more than 3 absences in the class.
3. A grade of 70 (Average for S2) or higher and no more than 2 absences in the class.
4. 3 tardies equal one absence.

AND

Part Two: *Fair and Respectful of others*

To be eligible for any senior exam exemptions, all four of the following criteria must be met during the second semester of the senior year:

1. No ADA (In School Suspension)
2. No Out of School Suspension
3. No DAEP placement
4. All Books turned in and Fines Paid
5. Completion of Senior Project or meet exemption requirements

- Students may elect to take an exam if they feel it would benefit their grade.
- The grade computation and attendance guidelines will be computed after the 6th six weeks progress report on **May 11th, 2012**.
- Students may not use community service as a substitute for grades or absences.
- Only school field trips, doctor's notes, and college visits will be exempt from absences. All other student absences will count toward exemption totals.
- This policy applies to AP and non AP classes.
- If students qualify for a senior exam exemption, the final S2 average will be duplicated as the final exam grade.
